On the outside Jeffrey would have appeared a typical 21-year-old. He split his time between school and a much loved job at Mellow Mushroom. He spent time with family and friends and seemed to have finally come into his own. But underneath that happy-go-lucky personality was an ongoing struggle with the disease of addiction. Jeffrey fought bravely against the demons of prescription drug abuse but lost his battle on October 19, 2012.
